
WHERE EXPEDITIONS START.

San Jose, Costa Rica, July 5.—Regardless of the government's expressed determination to stop the formation here of expeditions for Cuba, it is known that a large expedition is ready to start. The men and supplies are on board ship, only waiting for the arrival of their leader. It is reported that the leader has arrived on these shores.

News is received that the government of Gen. Campos has impressed about 50 small vessels in Cuban waters into service to patrol the coast for filibustering expeditions.

HEAD OF THE REPUBLIC.

New York, July 5.—Leaders of the Cuban revolution in various parts of the country are flocking to New York to consult with the managers of the revolution here. Several have already come this week from Philadelphia, Key West and Tampa, and more are expected soon. The principal object is to see Thomas Estrada Palma, whom the Cubans everywhere recognize as president by virtue of his having been duly elected head of the republic of Cuba at its fall in the collapse of the revolution of 1868-'73.
