

## DEATH OF GEN. SAUCILLY.

Gen. Julio Saucilly died at his home at Elvira yesterday. He willed his military

title in the Cuban insurrection of 1895, rising from the ranks by notable bravery and energy. He also took part in the last Cuban revolution, but in 1907 he was captured by the Spaniards who tried and sentenced him to be imprisoned for life. Sanguly, however, claimed American citizenship, and through the intervention of the government at Washington he was released.
