

EMILY BROWN'S MURDERERS.

Anderson Perry on Trial for Instigating the Crime.

BALTIMORE, Jan. 26.—The trial of Burker Anderson Perry, accused of having instigated the murder of the white woman, Emily Brown, and selling the body to a medical college, was continued yesterday. The principal witness was Ross, who killed the woman, and who was convicted last week of murder in the first degree. Ross swore that Perry, who was janitor at the Maryland university, had for three weeks broached the subject of murdering Emily Brown every time they met. The day of the murder Perry filled Ross with whisky and urged him to do the killing. Witness then, with perfect composure, gave the details of the crime, told how he met Al. Hawkins and went to Emily Brown's room, where Ross smashed the woman's skull with a brick and Hawkins stabbed her, put the body in a bag, took it to the Maryland university and delivered it to Perry.
