

OUR CONSULATE HIT BY SANTIAGO BOMB

*Large Explosive Damages the
Offices on Second Floor of
Building in Cuba.*

SANTIAGO, Cuba, Feb. 13 (AP).—The United States consulate, located on the second floor of the Bank of Nova Scotia Building, was damaged tonight by the explosion of a large bomb.

The bomb exploded in the doorway of the building. The damage to the consulate on the second floor was believed to be considerable, but the extent was not immediately determined.

The explosion caused panic throughout the downtown section, and troops were called to disperse street crowds.
