

## CUBA LACKS NEWSPRINT

Leading Daily Issued in Yellow  
—Wrapping Paper Next

HAVANA, Jan. 12 (U.P.)—The *Diario de la Marina*, leading newspaper in Cuba and one of the oldest in Latin America, was published today on deep yellow paper because of the lack of regular newsprint.

The newspaper said that the yellow paper had been obtained "with the greatest difficulty" and that tomorrow's edition would be printed on "wrapping paper" obtained from the stocks of various department stores. Other newspapers in Cuba were also forced to adopt extraordinary measures, including the drastic reduction of the number of pages and of advertising.

It is understood that many Cuban newspapers will be forced to suspend publication because of the newsprint shortage.
