HAVANA, Cuba, Jan. 27—The Cuban Government has protested to Germany through the International Red Cross on the reported ill treatment of Cubans in German concentration camps, Dr. Emeterio Santovenia, Minister of State, said today. Red Cross and the Spanish Chargé d'Affaires in Havana, it said, sent a note to Germany stating that Germans interned in Cuba had been receiving treatment in accordance to international principles.
