

CUBA NAMES U. S. ENVOY

President Appoints Dr. Guillermo Belt as Ambassador

HAVANA, Oct. 30 — President Ramon Grau San Martin signed this afternoon a decree naming Dr. Guillermo Belt Ambassador to the United States. At the same time the President sent a message to the Senate asking confirmation of the appointment, which is expected to be given promptly.

Dr. Belt, a close friend of President Grau, accompanied him on a recent visit to Washington. During the revolutionary period of 1933, Dr. Belt, a young lawyer and a member of a prominent family, joined the students' fight against the existing regime. He was Secretary of Education in the short-lived Decespedes Administration that followed the ousting of Gen. Gerardo Machado y Morales and later was Mayor of Havana during the Mendieta Government.
