

CUBA VOIDS ARMS PERMITS

President Acts After Recent Wave of Gun Fights

HAVANA, Nov. 11—President Ramón Grau San Martín today canceled all licenses to carry arms and ordered the civilian population disarmed.

Recent killings and gun battles between civilians and authorities prompted the measure. Thousands hold licenses for arms throughout Cuba and it has long been customary for legislators, Government officials and politicians to carry revolvers. Police, soldiers and sailors have customarily carried side-arms, on or off duty.
