

GRAU TAKES OVER IN CUBA

Acts to Maintain Order After Series of Killings

HAVANA, Nov. 8 (U.P.)—President Ramon Grau San Martin has taken personal command of the maintenance of order in Cuba as a result of recent isolated killings, including three last night, Senator Eduardo Chibas, prominent Government leader in the Upper House, announced today.

Gen. Francisco Tabernilla, commander of the Cabaña fortress in Havana, denied rumors that he was the leader of a military movement against Señor Grau. "I am, before anything else, a Cuban and a military man and, as always, I am at the orders of the President of the republic," he said.
