HAVANA, Cuba, April 13 - A pro-Palestine Cuban committee was formed this afternoon to

awaken sympathy among the Cubans for Jewish immigration to Palestine. Dr. Gustavo Cutierrez, Cuban delegate to the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Association

was chosen president of the committee. Among the other members are Dr. Gustavo Cuervo Rusio, vice

president; Dr. Guas Inclan, Governor of Havana Province; Dr. Ofelia Dominguez, chief of the

Bureau of War Propaganda in the Ministry of Defense; Dr. Rodolfo Mendez Penate, rector of Havana University, and Dr. Desiderio Weiss, representative of the Jewish

colony in Cuba. The formation of the committee was in line with the campaign to

arouse sympathy for the Zionist cause throughout Latin America headed by Nathan Bistritsky, a

Jewish leader now in Cuba. A similar committee already was formed in Mexico by M. Bistritsky.
