

CUBAN PLOT CHARGED

7 Persons and 3 Arms Caches Seized by the Police

HAVANA, Oct. 6—A plot to assassinate President Fulgencio Batista and other high government officials was broken up by the capture of a cache of arms and the arrest of seven of the plotters, the chief of the Cuban National Police said today.

According to Chief Rafael Salas Canizares, Carlos del Amo Diaz, tax inspector, arrested yesterday, revealed the details of the conspiracy headed by former President Carlos Prío Socarras, now living in exile in Miami. Amo Diaz said the plan was to bring here two hired assassins, Mario Masipi and Alfredo Labre, and start terroristic activities Monday.

The authorities seized in Havana three caches of rifles, machine guns, revolvers and ammunition.

General Canizares also accused Generalissimo Rafael L. Trujillo, strongman of the Dominican Republic, of furnishing arms and aiding Cuban revolutionists.
