

Miami Demonstrators Freed

MIAMI. (AP) — A judge freed the bulk of more than 50 persons arraigned yesterday on charges stemming from a scuffle between police and Cuban revolutionary sympathizers in midtown Miami.

Fines of \$150 were levied on Mrs. Eva Gutierrez, 33, Albert Banco, 22, Arturo Munoz, 22 and Hector Cornielot, 18, in connection with rough handling which two policemen testified they got in halting an anti-Batista parade that marched toward the Cuban consulate.
