

All But 4 Cuban Demonstrators At Miami Are Freed

MIAMI, June 6. (AP)—All but four of 50 persons were freed in court today of charges stemming from a scuffle between police and a parade of anti-Batista Cubans and sympathizers.

Mrs. Eva Gutierrez, 33, charged with assault and battery and resisting arrest, was fined \$150. She said she did not remember pulling the lanyard of a police sergeant's whistle, the basis of charges against her.

Others fined \$150 each included Albert Blanco, 22, Arturo Munoz, 22, and Hector Cornielot, 18, all in connection with a disorder that followed police efforts to halt the parade toward the Cuban consulate. Two policemen testified they were beaten, knocked down and kicked.
