

Dynamite Found On Marx's Tomb

LONDON (UPI) — Scotland Yard said Wednesday several sticks of dynamite and a device to set them off were found last week on the tomb of Karl Marx.

A Scotland Yard spokesman said the Highgate Cemetery in North London was closed while the device was disarmed.

Details of the incident were disclosed after a leader of the anti-Communist Cuban Nationalist Association was reported to have said in the United States his organization was responsible.

A report received here quoted Santiago Gonzalez, identified as national vice director of the association, as saying "several of our war bonds and the Cuban national flag" were left on the tomb.

Marx had lived in Britain since 1948 after he was expelled from Germany. He died March 14, 1883.
