A report received here quoted Santiago Gonzalez, identified as

national vice director of the as-

sociation, as saying "several of our war bonds and the Cuban national flag" were left on the tomb.

Marx had lived in Britain since 1948 after he was ex-

since 1948 after he was expelled from Germany. He died March 14, 1883,
