ORDER

This matter having come before the Court upon oral motion of the defense, the United States not objecting thereto, and the Court having considered the matter, finds as follows:

On August 11, 1978, defendants Guillermo Novo Sampol, Alvin Ross Diaz and Ignacio Novo Sampol were arraigned in the above-captioned matter before this Court. Prior to their arraignment, defendants Novo and Ross were being held in the Metropolitan Correctional Center in New York City. Mr. Novo was being held following the revocation of probation in a prior matter while Mr. Ross was held pending the delivery of a warrant of removal in the instant case. The defendants have requested that they be returned to the Metropolitan Correctional Center in New York to allow them to prepare with their attorneys in New York. The defendants have indicated their understanding that this order is for their convenience and in no way vitiates the Court's jurisdiction over them. Therefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED, that the United States Marshals Service shall return Guillermo Novo Sampol and Alvin Ross Diaz to the Metropolitan Correctional Center in New York City, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Metropolitan Correctional Center retain custody of Guillermo Novo Sampol and Alvin Ross Diaz until further notification by this Court.
