

Cuba Exiles Claim Seizure of Papers

Miami, Aug. 10 (AP)—A Cuban exile group claimed today it captured valuable documents aboard the Cuban freighter Maria Teresa after dynamiting her in Montreal Harbor yesterday.

"We will soon make these documents public if that will help the cause of Cuban liberation," said Felipe Rivero, head of the National Assn., an anti-Castro organization.

Montreal police said there was an explosion at the freighter, but there was no damage.

Another exile group, Accion Cuba, also claimed credit for the attack.
