

U.S. Asks Chile to Question Two On '76 Slaying of Allende Aide

WASHINGTON, Feb. 21 (AP)—United States officials disclosed today that they are seeking to question two Chilean military men about the murder of Orlando Letelier, a former Chilean cabinet officer and diplomat, killed in a bomb explosion on a Washington street in 1976.

The possible connection of the two Chilean military men to the case was disclosed when the United States asked the Chilean Government to question the two about the assassination.
