It is noted that on January 12, 1970, Mr. [redacted] Rockville, Maryland was interviewed concerning one [redacted] a Cuban exile who resides in Washington, D.C. Information furnished by [redacted] indicated that [redacted] was involved in a plan to hijack a Soviet tanker with [redacted] allegedly was to collect arms and money to assist in this hijacking plan.

Concerning [redacted] on May 26, 1969, he contacted the office of the FBI in New York, New York and furnished his address as [redacted] Miami, Florida. During this visit [redacted] mentioned having spoken with [redacted] Washington, D.C. and noted that both he and [redacted] were members of the Cuban Exile Brigade 2506, which had participated in an unsuccessful invasion attempt of Cuba at Bay of Pigs in April, 1961.
