

Ex-Castro Captain Is Electrocuted

MIAMI, May 12 (UPI) — A former leader in Fidel Castro's rebel army was electrocuted Thursday while working on the generator of a boat anchored in the Miami river.

Authorities said Jorge Sotus, 28, received a fatal shock when a drill he was using came in contact with electric wiring. One of Castro's first captains, Sotus was cited for heroic action but later broke with Castro and left Cuba in 1959.
