

# 'FLNC' scribblings of terrorists

Those "FLNC" scribblings mysteriously popping up all over Little Havana storefronts mean "Frente de Liberacion Cubana" (National Front of Cuban Liberation), a terrorist group with clandestine cells based here and in Puerto Rico.

Dedicated to the ouster of Fidel Castro, the group has taken credit for the recent bombing of a Bahamian ship docked at Miami River.

FLNC also claims responsibility for two bombings of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City in December and January, and the destruction of five "Castro spy ships." They figure such tactics will inspire "internal insurrection in Cuba."
