

Miami's Cubans To Be Honored

MIAMI (AP) — Miami Mayor Stephen P. Clark yesterday proclaimed next Saturday and Sunday as "Cuban Freedom Fighters Days" in honor of the large Cuban exile colony.

Clark urged "freedom loving" Americans and Cubans to attend a ceremony at 11 a.m. Saturday at the statue of Jose Marti, Cuban independence hero, in Bayfront Park.

One of the largest exile organizations, the Cuban Exile Representation (Rece), will open a two-day convention after the ceremony to plan anti-Castro strategy. Delegates are expected from New York, Chicago, Los Angeles, Washington, Baltimore, New Orleans, Detroit, Houston and Dallas, Jacksonville and Tampa, Puerto Rico and other points with large Cuban populations.
