

# Cuban Exiles Eye Support For Offensive

MIAMI (AP) — A Cuban exile conference eyed the American election campaign yesterday as it looked for support of its announced offensive against Fidel Castro.

“The two parties participating in the elections must be made aware of Communist Cuba dangers for the United States and the hemisphere,” chairman Jose Miguel Portuondo told the assembly of 48 delegates from 25 states and Puerto Rico.

“We must show to a point of satiety the need for all to cooperate in the liberation of Cuba.”

Portuondo addressed the closing session of the first congress of the Cuban Exile Representation (RECE), a major anti-Castro group.

He spoke after RECE had approved a declaration of principles saying “the armed revolution that we are waging must be carried on by Cubans.”
