

Mayors' support sought for Castro foe

State Sen. Ileana Ros-Lehtinen, R-Miami, has asked mayors of Dade County cities to declare March the month of liberty for anti-Castro militant Orlando Bosch, who is detained by federal immigration officials.

As part of the monthlong campaign, Ros-Lehtinen and Bosch's family will be asking for legislators, Hispanic officials and Dade's principal organizations to sign letters to federal officials in support of Bosch.

They will be asking for signatures for the release of Bosch during the Calle Ocho Festival, which starts March 12. They plan to hold news conferences to generate community support.

Adriana Bosch, the wife of the anti-Castro activist, said the Immigration and Naturalization Service has taken too long to decide her husband's case. Bosch has been detained at the Metropolitan Correctional Center in Southwest Dade since he flew illegally to the United States from Venezuela last year. *miami Herald 2-14-84-2B*
