Mack asks INS to free Bosch

U.S. Sen Connie Mack, R-Fla., called on the Immigration and Naturalization Service Thursday to free anti-Castro militant Orlando Bosch, held in a federal jail in Southwest Dade for more than a year pending a decision on whether to deport him.

"The freedoms we enjoy in America work in large part because

of the compassion that guides our decisions," Mack said. "Dr. Bosch

deserves the same kind of compassion from us that he has given to the cause of freedom."

Bosch returned to the United States last year, after 11 years of imprisonment in Venezuela, where he was acquitted of masterminding the 1976 bombing of a Cuban airliner in which 73 people died.
