**Havana should try  
Bosch, official says**

Anti-Castro activist Orlando Bosch, facing deportation proceedings in the United States, should be tried in Cuba, according to the state news agency Prensa Latina.

A Prensa Latina dispatch monitored in Mexico City quoted Antonio Rodriguez Gaviria, a specialist in criminal law of the Cuban Justice Ministry, as saying that "there are laws to try Bosch" in Cuba.

Rodriguez Gaviria added: "Bosch should be extradited to this country, but it is not juridically possible, because there are no [extradition] treaties between the governments of Cuba and the United States".
