Ship Bomber Fasts In Jail

A Cuban exile began a hunger strike yesterday in Dade County Jail, where he is being held on charges he planted an underwater bomb which ripped open the hull of a Spanish freighter docked in San Juan, P.R., Oct. 9.

Jose Rodriguez Perez, 38, who was arrested by FBI agents Thursday at 235 NE 162nd St., North Miami Beach, undertook his hunger strike, he said, in protest against the charge. He was jailed in lieu of \$25,000 bond.

Perez is a member of the Miami - based Insurrectional Revolutionary Recovery Movement (MIRR), an active anti-Castro group whose leader, Dr. Orlando Bosch, who is currently free on \$5,000 bond on charges he tried to extort money from other Cuban exiles.
