

New Cuban Group Urged

MIAMI (AP) A Cuban exile organization, the Insurreccional Movement for recovery of the Revolution, yesterday called on the Revolutionary Council to resign. The council, headed by Jose Miro Cardona, directed the ill-fated April 17 invasion.

The insurreccional movement, in a manifesto signed by its co-ordinator, Orlando Bosch, urged formation of a new central revolutionary body.

It also recommended "revision of our present and future relations with the United States and the CIA."

It suggested an intensive anti-Castro and anti-Communist publicity campaign throughout the Americas.
