THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

That on or about April 14, 1967, in the Valdosta Division of the Middle District of Georgia, ORLANDO BOSCH Y AVILA and BARBARO BALAN Y GARCIA did knowingly, wilfully and unlawfully attempt to export from Tifton, Georgia, to a point outside the United States, articles designated by the United States Munitions List (Title 22, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 121.01), that is, arms, ammunition and implements of war, to wit:

- (1) Four pipe bombs;
- (2) Two half-gallon plastic jugs containing incendiary white phosphorus and water;

without having first obtained a license therefor or having written approval from the United States Department of State; all in violation of Title 22, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 126.01 and 22 U.S.C. § 1934(c).
