> Yesterday afternoon depositions were taken in my office by attorneys Jeff Weiner, Sam Shares, and Juan Ramirez. During the course of the deposition of Technician John Lurvey, it became apparent to defense counsel that Manuel Ortega was in Dade County and, specifically, in what facility he was located. Weiner and Shares are partners in the law firm that represents Castillo. Ramirez is of counsel, and, as such, is not an attorney of record but he is assisting the firm that represents Castillo. Ramirez, you should note for your records, based upon testimony that he attempted to give at Castillo's bond hearing at which Danny Benitez was present, is a friend of Castillo and during the time that Castillo was being sought after by the F.B.I. in relation to the Federal Grand Jury probe, Ramirez was in contact with Castillo based on his own testimony and, at one point, was in contact with somebody, either with the F.B.I. or the U.S. Attorney's Office, according to himself, with reference to the charges against Castillo. is my belief that Ramirez is subject to some investigation and you may wish to do a background check of him. To the best of my knowledge, he is a full member of the Florida Bar.

> Immediately after the whereabouts of Ortega became known, I contacted your division and spoke to Jack Curtin. explained to Curtin what had just occurred and I indicated to him that there might be a need to move Ortega for security purposes, and I asked that the jail be contacted and that under no circumstances, for security reasons, should anybody be allowed to visit Ortega except for myself or somebody connected with the Public Safety Department. I additionally told him to immediately contact Danny Benitez and have Benitez contact me so that we could set up a meeting with Ortega so that I could have a conversation with him. I never received a call from Benitez last night and, at one point, Detective Austin, of the City of Miami Police Department, called me at approximately 5:30 p.m., and told me that Danny was with him and told me that he would have Danny call me right back but, Danny did not.

> More importantly, I was informed this morning by an Assistant State Attorney who was in the men's room sometime yesterday afternoon and overheard a conversation between who he believes to be Juan Ramirez and Sam Shares. A copy of a memorandum I requested from him is included with this memo to you.
