Note.—Full text of question 24 has follows: Whether a person who believes in or advocates the overthrow by force or violence of the Government of the United States or of all forms of Govt, or who disbelieves in or is opposed to organized government, or who advocates the nomination of public officials, or who advocates or teaches the unlawful destruction of property, or is a member of an organization having such an organization, or who is a member of an organization or which teaches the unlawful destruction of property, or who advocates or teaches the duty, necessity, or propriety of the unlawful smothering or killing of any officer or officers, either of specific individuals or of officers generally, of the Government of the United States or of any other organized government because of his or their official character.
