Joseph Fernandez being duly sworn deposes and says that he resides at No. 426 Bedford Avenue, Borough of Brooklyn, that he is the claimant who filed an application for a pension said application being known as No. 1347555.

Deponent further says that he enlisted in Co "B" 100 Reg N Y Volunteer Infantry, under the name of "Juan Albes" for the reason that at about the time he left Spain, his native country, in Oct 1863 he was drafted to serve in the army and came to this country to evade such service, that he was informed by friends that if he enlisted under his right name the Spanish Government would send over and take him back to the old country and for that reason alone deponent enlisted under the aforesaid alias.

Deponent further says that his name is spelled in Spanish "Jose" and in English "Joseph" that he has used the last way of spelling his name for many years.
