

LEAVENWORTH, Jan. 31.—General order No. 12 in the department of Kansas, prohibits troops of this department from entering the department of Missouri without special orders. All armed parties, whether belonging to the service of the Government or not, who shall hereafter cross the Kansas border and enter the Missouri department without due authority, shall be adjudged to have entered for purposes of depredation, and shall be held subject to the penalties of military law. All armed bands of men in the State of Kansas not in the service of the United States, now acting under special authority obtained from the Governor of the State or the General Commanding, are hereby warned to disband and return to their homes. Military commissions for the trial of all such persons and all who are now detained on charges of armed depredations of jayhawking, will be established.
