Orders

This command will cross the Great Pee Dee tomorrow morning in the following order:

First, McLaws Division will move at four o'clock, except Fiser's Brigade which will move at seven o'clock.

Second, Taliaferro's Division will move at seven o'clock. Fiser's Brigade will follow Taliaferro's Division.

3<sup>rd</sup> Maj. Gen. Butler will send one Brigade of Cavalry over the Pee Dee tonight & thence via Rockingham to guard the Pee Dee at the crossing of the Wadesboro & Rockingham & Suedsboro & Rockingham roads. The other Brigade will keep in rear of Fiser's Brigade of Infantry & hold the enemy in check until the Infantry have crossed the Pee Dee Bridge & bring up the rear.

4<sup>th</sup> The Artillery attached to Division's

will be sent across the river tonight

The Reserve Artillery which is already  
beyond the Pee Dee will proceed tomorrow  
morning to Rockingham N.C.

5<sup>th</sup> The Chief Dr. Mr. will load up  
all wagon trains in Cheraw tonight  
& start them across the river at once.

The Division baggage train now across  
the Pee Dee will be loaded tonight &  
proceed as early as practicable tomorrow  
morning to Swata Mill on the road  
running by Hannington to Rockingham.

The general supply train beyond Pee Dee  
will be loaded tomorrow morning & will  
proceed to Rockingham following the march  
of McLaws' Division & preceding Talia-  
ferro's.

6<sup>th</sup> Col. Clarke, Chf. Eng<sup>r</sup> will pro-  
ceed to Rockingham with the Engineer  
troops tomorrow morning preparing the road  
as he goes.

7<sup>th</sup> Maj. Genl Butler is charged with  
the duty of burning the depot at Cheraw,  
& destroying the bridge over the Great Pee Dee  
when everything has passed over.

8<sup>th</sup> Lt. Col. Memminger is charged  
with the duty of burning the Rail Road

Bridge over Thompson's creek when the Rail way  
trains have passed.

9<sup>th</sup> Capt. Gayer, Prov. Marshall, will burn  
the Cocton tomorrow morning.
