Order of march for tomorrow 5th inst.

1. Anderson's and Godwyn's Brigades of Calhoun's Division and the Reserve Arty. all under charge of Col. Anderson, will march at 2 A.M. on the Ashboro' road via Fair Ground to Postick's Mill and encamp a mile beyond.
2. The General supply train will move at 4 A.M. and encamp at Postick's.
3. Remainder of Calhoun's Division and his Division train will move at 5 p A.M. to Postick's.
4. M. Law's Division and Division train will start at 7 A.M. taking the right-hand road at Fair Ground and encamp at Martin's.
5. Butler's Division train will follow in rear of M. Law's Division.
6. Hardy's Brigade and the two Batteries of Arty. under his charge will move at 9 A.M. (unless compelled by the enemy to start sooner)
