General Orders  
 No 7

I. In accordance with General Order No 24 from Dept  
 Hd Qu bearing date Feby 7<sup>th</sup> 1863, Private Jacob Adams  
 of Company "B" 46<sup>th</sup> Regt Ga Vols P.C.S and private John  
 Edmunds of Company "C" Charleston Battalion P.C.S. will be  
 "Shot to death with Musketry" at the Race Course near  
 Charleston at 12 o'clock M on Friday the 20<sup>th</sup> day of  
 Feby 1863.

II. All Troops in Charleston will be turned out under Com-  
 mand of Col P. H. Colquhitt, at 11 o'clock A.M. of the same  
 day to witness the execution. The 46<sup>th</sup> Regt Ga Vols, Lieut Col W.  
 A Daniels Comd, will be armed and equipped. All other troops  
 will appear with Side Arms only.

III. The Comd Officers of Co "B" 46<sup>th</sup> Regt Ga Vols & Co "C" Charleston  
 Battalion will each make a detail of twelve men from their  
 respective Companies to carry out the duties of the Court  
 Martial, providing them with Muzz loaded and then  
 unloaded Muskets for that purpose.

IV. A Reserve detail of twelve men with Arms similarly  
 loaded will be made from each of the above men-  
 tioned Companies, in case they are needed to complete  
 the execution.

V. Lieut Col P. C. Gilliard Military Provost Marshal  
 is charged with the details of, and execution of  
 this order.
