General Orders  
 No 9

I - In accordance with paragraph 3<sup>rd</sup> of General Orders No 17, Current series from Department Head Quarters, bearing date January 28<sup>th</sup> 1863, Privates J Sullivan and H W Bishop of 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion Sharpshooters, will be "Shot to death with Musketry," at the Race Course near Charleston at 12 O'Clock M. on Saturday the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 1863.

II - All troops in Charleston will be turned out under Command of Col J H Colquitt at 11 O'Clock A. M. of the same day to witness the execution - The 46<sup>th</sup> Regt Geo Vols Lieut Col W W Daniel Comdg will be armed and equipped - All other troops will appear with side arms only.

III - A detail of twenty four men from the troops in the City of Charleston will be made, to carry out the sentence of the Court Martial, provided with twelve loaded, and twelve unloaded muskets for that purpose.

IV - A Reserve detail of twenty four men with guns similarly loaded will be made, in case they are needed to complete the execution.

V - Lieut Col J C Gaillard Military Provost Marshal is charged with the details of, and execution of this Order.
