survivors are in the Sierra Socarrena, in a famished condition. The outlets of the Sierra are guarded, and the capture of the entire expedition is considered certain. A band of Chinese insurgents have appeared in the Sagua jurisdiction. On the 15th inst. they burned the Peralta warehouses, with 300 hogsheads of sugar, and killed the clerk and watchman.
