GOICOURIA and some of his followers have escaped from Camaguey and gone toward Las Tunas....The Government troops in the vicinity of Trinidad have recently killed one hundred insurgents....A Judge yesterday illegally released the Masons who were in jail....Capt.-Gen. DE RODAS thereupon placed the Judge in the Morro Castle, and ordered the Masons to report themselves to the City Jail as under arrest.
