CUBA.

Capture of Gen. Goicouria—The Search for the Remainder of Mis Party—Departure for Mayana for Trial.

HAVANA, May 6.—Two sailors belonging to a Spanish man-of-war captured the rebel Gen. GOICOURIA on Guajaba Island. The remainder of GOICOURIA'S party, consisting of a Canadian, three pilots, and two Cubans, named AGIARO, are still at large on the island, and three Spanish gun-boats are closely watching to prevent their escape. After Gen. Goicouria's capture he was taken to Puerto Principe, and soon after ordered by Capt.-Gen. DE Rodas to be taken to Hayana, under a guard of paval officers, for trial. His arrival is expected in this city to-morrow.
