

Court Orders Probe Of Terrorist Attempt

The Urgency Court of Hayana yesterday ordered an investigation of an apparent frustrated terrorist attack on the Soviet Legation in Paseo and 15th Street, Vedado, and police were detailed to try to ascertain the identity of the people who planted the bomb which failed to explode there Tuesday.

The bomb—a powerful 12-inch bomb loaded with dynamite and bullets—failed to explode because of the rapidity with which the policeman Javier Coto Maza, of the Eighth Police Station, yanked out the fuse, which was already half burned, according to a statement prepared by Captain Felix Cabrera, chief of that station.
