

All Strikebound Airlines Resume Normal Service

All the airlines affected by Tuesday's lightning strike of ground personnel and pilots at the Rancho Boyeros airport resumed normal service early yesterday morning.

According to a note handed to the press by the "Compania Cubana de Aviacion," in connection with resumption of the service, traffic at the airport all day yesterday was intense and all planes for Miami were leaving with their full complement of passengers. It added that extra clippers and DC-4's of the PAA were pressed into service to carry 400 passengers to Miami.

Meanwhile, it was learned at the Palace that President Prio had roundly refused to order the release of the pilots and workers who were arrested, leaving it to the free decision of the courts. The Urgency Court yesterday morning released the prisoners on bail.
