

# Red Cross Heroine To Be Honored In Santiago de Cuba

A bust of Clara Barton, then president of the American Red Cross will be unveiled, in recognition of her selfless aid to Cuba's suffering population during the Spanish-American War, during ceremonies to be held in her honor in Santiago de Cuba Sunday, July 22.

Besides the unveiling of the bust, there will be a military parade in which Army, Marine and Police forces, Red Cross brigades and American Marines, who will be sent to Santiago for the purpose, will participate. That night, the First Exhibition of International Dolls offered in Cuba by the Red Cross will be closed with ceremonies in honor of Clara Barton.

Clara Barton landed in Santiago de Cuba in the middle of the Spanish-American War, persuaded the Spanish army to respect the safety zones fixed by the Red Cross, and toured the island, carrying clothing, food and medicine to the places affected by the struggle.
