CUBANS DUEL TO DRAW Judge Orders Senator and Former Minister to Reconcile

HAVANA, Feb. 17 (A)—Senator Eduardo Chibas and former Minister of State Alberto Inocente Alvarez dueled with sabers for three round early today in the saloon of the National Capitol and both received hard blows on their backs, shoulders and arms.

Field Judge Maria Rivas then halted the duel and invited the opponents to reconcile, which they

halted the duel and invited the opponents to reconcile, which they did "diplomatically." The fight resulted from a radio attack by Señor Alvarez in reply to charges made by Señor Chibas. Although duels are forbidden by law, House Speaker Roben de Leon and Prof. Aurelio Sanchez Arango served as seconds for Señor Alvarez. Señor Chibas was seconded by Representatives Manuel Bisbee and José

Garcia Barcena.
