

Cubans Protest Chibas' Jailing

HAVANA, April 28—A petition asking that the sentence of six months imprisonment imposed yesterday on Dr. Eduardo Chibas, head of the Cuban People's party, be annulled, was presented to the Supreme Court today by Dr. Francisco Carone, attorney for Dr. Chibas, who is now in Principe Fortress jail. Other protests have poured in upon the Government since he was sentenced after having been found guilty of slandering Supreme Court judges in the press and by radio broadcasts.
