

# **BATISTA IS ACCUSED OF HAVING RED AIDES**

## ***Member of Cuban Congress Says Colonel May Lose Presidency***

HAVANA, Aug. 27—Eduardo Chibas, who was elected to the House of Representatives by the Cuban Revolutionary party in the elections of last July, today accused the President-elect, Colonel Fulgencio Batista, of being under the influence of Fascist and Communist advisers. He declared it was probable the colonel would not take office in October.

In an interview published by APM, the only English afternoon newspaper, Señor Chibas said:

"If the complaints against the polling continue to be considered and a recount of votes is made in many precincts, Dr. Ramon Grau San Martin, and not Batista, will be Cuba's next President.

"Cuba cannot feel safe from totalitarian dangers because of her distance from the European continent. In our own country Cuban Reds obey the orders of Moscow, and even Colonel Batista not so long ago tried to establish fascism here, in military-ruled schools and health and welfare corporations.

"The Colonel's close friends do not conceal their admiration for Hitler and Mussolini. We must not forget that Batista's main campaign head was a Communist and his advisers today are other rabid Reds."

Senor Chibas was a revolutionist during the Machado regime and long has been an enemy of Colonel Batista.
