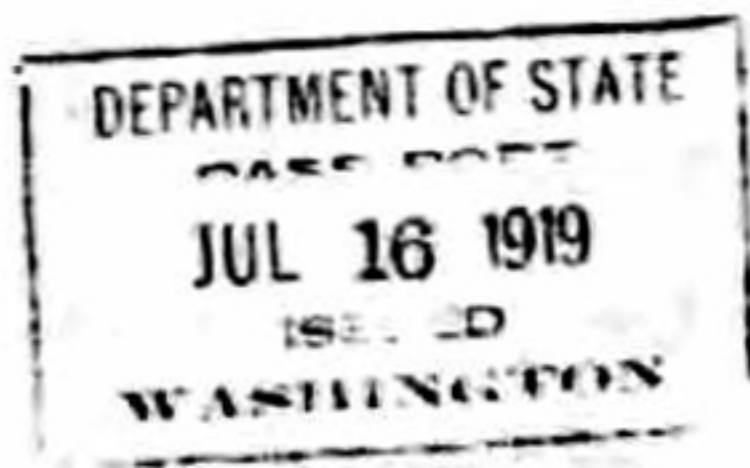


The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background and be not over three inches in size.

Fee for passport, one dollar.  
Fee for executing application, one dollar.

I solemnly swear that I was born at New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 2 day of April, 1888;\* that my father Daniel M. Guiteras, was born in Matanzas, Cuba, and is now residing at 315 W. 94 St., New York, N.Y.

[that he emigrated to the United States from the port of Havana, Cuba (If the applicant's father or husband was born in this country, lines should be drawn through the blanks in brackets.)

on or about 1868; that he resided 51 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1868 to 1919, at New York, Pensacola & Phila.; that he was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the Bay Court of Bay, at Bay, on Bay, 1 Bay, as shown by the Certificate of Naturalization presented herewith];

that I have resided outside the United States at the following places for the following periods:  
Chile, from Feb., 1916 to Feb., 1918;

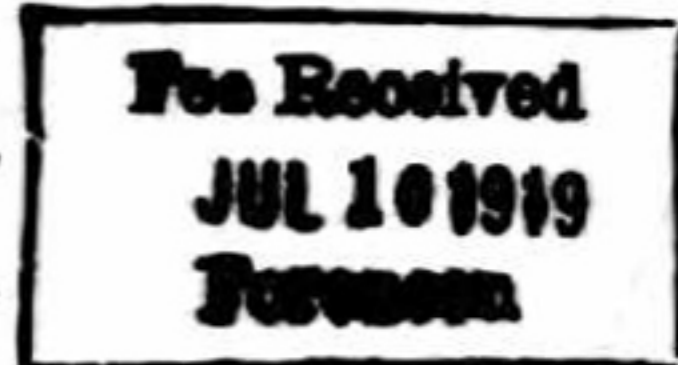
