

PLOT CHARGED IN CUBA

12 Held in Move to Assassinate Minister, Police Say

HAVANA, June 14—A plot to assassinate Dr. Santiago Rey, Minister of the Interior, has been discovered, Maj. Martin Perez, chief of the motorized section of the National Police said today. Eleven suspects were arrested early this morning.

Meanwhile, a soldier was shot and killed by two youths on an omnibus in Santiago de Cuba, capital of Oriente Province. The driver of the bus was wounded.

The reason for the shooting was not explained. Oriente Province has been a center of anti-Government activity.
