

GEN. JOSE MARTI

Son of Cuban Patriot Was Aide to Garcia Against Spaniards

HAVANA, Oct. 22—Gen. José Marti y Zayas Bazan, son of the Cuban patriot, José Marti, died here this morning at his home in the Vedado residential section after a long illness. His age was 67.

Born in this city, General Marti joined the final Cuban campaign against the Spaniards for independence and was an aide to Gen. Calixto Garcia. During the Menocal administration he served as Secretary of War and the Navy. He leaves a widow, Maria Teresa.

President Grau San Martin today decreed official mourning for General Marti until the funeral. Burial will take place tomorrow with full military honors.
