Former President of Cuba Will Put Wreath on Lincoln Tomb

CHICAGO, March 25—Gen. Fulgencio Batista, former President of Cuba, arrived here today with members of his family and other former Cuban officials, on a three-day visit during a tour of the United States.

The party will travel tomorrow

to Springfield, where General Batista will place a wreath on Lincoln's tomb.

"I have admired Lincoln as the representative of the highest ideals for mankind since I was a boy and I have looked forward to the time when I could pay such homage to him," he said.

Commenting on the recent report of a plot against the government of Cuba, General Batista said he "condemned any movement to break up Cuba's constitutional form of government."
